Current research shows that student achievement is related to good school attendance. At primary school attendance is really important, as much of the learning is building on the previous days work.

Attending regularly is defined as attending over 90% of half days.

South School Attendance Term 1 2019

68.5% of students attended regularly in Term 1 2019.

Year 1 students have the highest regular attendance of 85.7%. Year 6 had the lowest % of students attending regularly at 60 %. More boys attended regularly than girls, particularly in Years 7 and 8.

Comment on attendance

Clearly we can do a lot better. It is very concerning when we compare attendance levels to student achievement. As an important part of improved student wellbeing, we need to work with our community. Our staff and board are now reviewing all aspects related to student attendance and our parents/whanau will be part of this . We need to look at ways of providing whanau with a meaningful voice on this issue.
