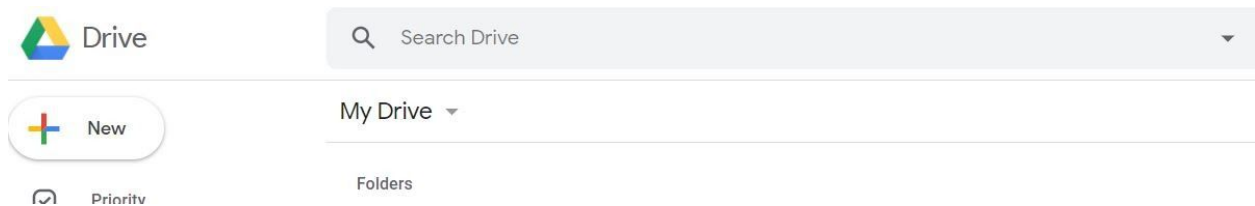
Hi Te Puawai whanau,
