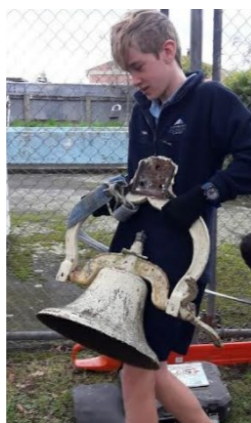


School Uniforms
