Please note:

- There is a chance we may need to postpone the tournament until later in Term 2 or Term 3. Upgrades are scheduled for both the Anderson Street Tennis Courts and Netball Courts. We will communicate any changes as soon as we can. Any postponements will apply to all junior hockey (ie. including the Yr 7/8s at the high school).
- Junior Hockey will run for a 10 week season - this includes any disruptions due to the upgrade and allows for any weather cancellations. We may play hockey in the first weeks of Term 3 to make up a full 10 week tournament.
- Register before 31 March 2023 - we want to encourage our players but late registrations may be declined depending on team numbers.
